A local march is planned for January 21st, in solidarity with the Women's March on Washington, D.C. It will begin at 10 a.m. at Bellingham City Hall, 210 Lottie St., and go until noon.

National AAUW encourages branch members to attend one of the many Sister Marches, such as the one in Bellingham, which are planned throughout the nation. Organizers say they anticipate a turnout of 3,000 or more in Bellingham. The event begins at City Hall with speakers and music, followed by a march through downtown Bellingham; then more speakers and music, plus a "community connections fair"-to allow people to connect with local organizations.
